Please note that membership commits the member to payment of the full year membership fee (or pro-rata if starting after 1 April) New members who start after 1 April are required to pay 1/12th of the yearly fee for every month remaining starting from the 1st of the current month. e.g. a start date of 9 Nov. means a 5/12th fee payable for the 5 months from 1 Nov-31 March.

Conditions of Membership

Rowing and its associated training is a strenuous activity. You should therefore be in good health and have no medical or physical condition precluding heavy exercise. If there is any doubt you should first consult your Doctor. Some conditions such as asthma and diabetes do not prevent individuals participating in the sport, but you have a duty to declare any condition that might put yourself or others at risk. Likewise you have a duty to declare any change in personal health which may put yourself or others at risk.

For your safety it is important that you are a competent swimmer. As a minimum you must be able to swim 50 metres in light clothing, swim underwater for 5 metres and tread water for 2 minutes. If you declare that you cannot meet this requirement you must wear a lifejacket at all times when in a boat. In due course you may be required to pass a swim test to demonstrate your competence.
